South Carolina is the latest state to implement an E-Waste Recycling Law to reduce landfill volume, recycle valuable materials and help reduce cost of creating new products.

Lexington County accepts e-scrap at the Edmund C&D Landfill from residents (5 items per visit) and businesses (\$39.45 per ton).

Accepted Items Include:

Computers; monitors; telephones and cell phones; fax machines and central office equipment; printers; televisions; microwaves; banking, financial and medical equipment; rechargeable batteries; radio and stereo equipment; games and PDAs.
